
13 Distal section of trochanters of 2nd and 3rd legs with ventral row of long flexuous setae..... 14

Note: Parietal bands (pb) and pleural band (plb) indistinct or absent. Sclerite of the '9th abdominal dorsum with at least 1 intermediate setae (is) between the innermost and outermost primary setae (IP-OP) which is almost as long as outermost primary setae (OP).

Case curved, of plant material, sometimes partly or entirely of sand grains. Shallow permanent or temporary (usually acidic) open pools in mainland and in islands of Baltic Sea. Common in south, absent in extreme north.
